

# **DRESS CODE POLICY**

The following dress code policy will be enforced at Four Corners Montessori Academy (FCMA) for all students in grade levels Pre-Primary-8th Grade. Dress code infractions in question will be left to the discretion of school administration.

### **GENERAL ATTIRE:**

> Pants/Shorts (Shorts no shorter than two inches above the knee):

Navy or khaki

- Shirts (Polo, Button Down, Turtleneck)- Solid color only, no logo other than FCMA: Pale yellow, white, maroon, or hunter green
- Jumpers (Pre-Primary-3rd Grade) (No shorter than two inches above the knee):
  Drop waist- FCMA school plaid, navy or khaki
- ➤ Skirts/Skorts (Pre-Primary-8th Grade) (No shorter than two inches above the knee): FCMA school plaid, navy or khaki
- Sweaters (Vest, Cardigan, Pullover) Solid color only, no logo other than FCMA: Pale yellow, white, maroon, or hunter green. Cardigans can be navy as well.
- Socks, Tights, and Leggings (leggings and tights MUST be worn under a skirt or jumper):
  White, navy, or black (Solid color only)
- Shoes (Should be comfortable dress or canvas shoes): Black, brown, or navy (Solid color only)

#### **GYM ATTIRE:**

Pants/Shorts:

Hunter green or maroon

T-Shirts:

Hunter green, white, or maroon (These can be plain or Spirit-Wear/Fun Run shirts)

### MIDDLE SCHOOL (7TH & 8TH GRADE):

**▶** Hoodies:

Students are permitted to wear their FCMA middle school hoodies

> Shoes:

Students do not need indoor shoes

> Socks:

Students are permitted to wear any type of sock (no characters/school appropriate)

## DRESS CODE POLICY

### **ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:**

- Backpacks and lunch boxes need to have NO characters on them.
- Hats, visors, bandanas, and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building.
- Jewelry if worn should be lightweight, simple in style, and kept to a minimum.
- No body piercing except ears.
- Hair should be neat, clean, and styled in an appropriate style that does not obstruct the view of the face. No distracting style will be permitted.
- > Shirts must be neatly tucked into waistbands. No t-shirts or layered shirting of any kind.
- Students may not wear transparent tops without adequate undergarments.
- ➤ Only students in grades 7th & 8th are permitted to wear makeup, however, must be appropriate to the learning environment.
- Polo dresses are not permitted.

### **SPIRIT WEAR DAYS:**

Every Friday, students can wear any spirit wear (Fun Run, Pink Out, Earth Day shirt) with jeans. Jeans MAY NOT be ripped or torn.

#### **DRESS DOWN DAYS:**

Students may come to school dressed out of uniform.

Students must follow the below guidelines during Dress Down Day:

- No characters
- No ripped or torn clothing
- No bare midriffs
- No mini skirts
- No short shorts
- No flip-flops or open toes shoes
- No off-the-shoulder shirts/dresses
- Straps must be no thinner than 2 inches

### PROCEDURES FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

First Offense: Verbal and written warning.

**Second Offense:** Contact with parent; removal from class with a chance to correct and return to class.

Third Offense: Parent Conference with Head of school.
